

Unaudited interim consolidated financial statements (free translation)

Nine months ending September 30, 2017

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Basis of preparation

These IFRS condensed interim financial statements of the Coface Group as at September 30, 2017 are established in accordance with IAS 34 – Interim Financial Reporting, as adopted by the European Union.

The interim financial statements include:

- the balance sheet;
- the income statement;
- the consolidated statement of comprehensive income;
- the statement of changes in equity;
- the statement of cash flows;

They are presented with comparative financial information at December 31, 2016 for balance sheet items, and for the 9 months ended September 30, 2016 for income statement items.

The accounting principles and policies used for the interim financial statements as at September 30, 2017 are the same as the ones used for the year ended December 31, 2016. They are prepared in accordance with the International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) as adopted by the European Union1. They are detailed in the note 3 "Applicable Accounting Standards" of the consolidated financial statements for the year ended December 31, 2016.

The condensed consolidated financial statements were reviewed by the Coface Group's Board of Directors on October 25, 2017.

Significant events

Coface Central Europe Holding: acquisition of minority interests

Coface now wholly owns its subsidiary Coface Central Europe Holding, having acquired 25% of the share capital held since 1990 by KSV1870, an Austrian debt collection and information company. The shares were acquired on March 27th, for an amount of 6.5 million euros.

Tax review in France

Compagnie française d'assurance pour le commerce extérieur received a notice of a tax review, dated January 10, 2017 issued by la Direction des verifications nationales et internationales. The review is covering fiscal years 2014 and 2015.

Signing of social agreements in France and Germany

A new social agreement was signed in France with the employees' representative bodies on May 17. This agreement provides, starting in January 2018, of a working time organisation more in line with market practices and taking better account of the social and economic issues of the Group.

The voluntary redundancy plan, in Germany, which was presented to the staff representative bodies last November, was signed on May 10. It concerns the suppression of 83 positions. This plan is part of a provision for restructuring recorded in the financial statements for the year ended December 31, 2016.

Syndicated loan agreement

As part of the refinancing of its factoring activities, COFACE SA signed an agreement with a group of banking partners for a €700 million syndicated euro loan on 28 July 2017. This syndicated loan replaces existing bilateral credit lines.

The Group is supported by six banking partners: Natixis, Société Générale, BNPParibas, Crédit Agricole CIB, acting as Mandated Lead Arrangers and Bookrunners, HSBC and BRED acting as Mandated Lead Arrangers. Natixis is acting as Documentation Agent and Société Générale as Facility Agent.

The loan is put in place for three years, with an option to extend its duration by one year, exercisable twice, subject to the banks' agreement.

This operation enables the Group to increase its financial flexibility and to extend the maturity of its refinancing debt, whilst benefiting from current favorable market conditions and strengthening its relationships with its leading banks, who thus confirm their commitment to Coface over the mid-term.
